



With the two tablets of stone in his hands, Moses went up the mounpectant faith and yield to his work in our lives. Ask the Lord Jesus to renew in you the gift before him and proclaimed, 'Lord, Lord, a God of tenderness and of the Holy Spirit who strengthens us in the seven-fold gifts of wiscompassion, slow to anger, rich in kindness and faithfulness.' True, they are a headstrong people, but forgive us our faults too shall begin to look not at what is seen but at what is not seen. May he open the eyes that are concerned not with the present but with what is yet to come, may he unseal the heart's vision, that we may gaze on God in the Spirit, through the same Lord, Jesus Christ, whose glory and power will endure throughout the unending succession of ages. 
