

(R.) A light rises in the darkness for the upright.

- 1. He is a light in the darkness for the upright: he is generous, merciful and just. The good man takes pity and lends. he conducts his affairs with honour. (R.)
- 2. The just man will never waver: he will be remembered for ever. He has no fear of evil news: with a firm heart he trusts in the Lord. (R.)

A reading from the first letter of St Paul to the Corinthians

When I came to you, brothers, it was not with any show of oratory or philosophy, but simply to tell you what God had guaranteed. During my stay with you, the only knowledge I claimed to have was about Jesus, and only about him as the crucified Christ. Far from relying on any power of my own, I came among you in great 'fear and trembling' and in my speeches and the sermons that I gave, there were none of the arguments that belong to philosophy; only a demonstration of the power of the Spirit. And I did this so that your faith should not depend on human philosophy but on the power of God.

GOSPEL

Mt 5:13 - 16

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Matthew

Jesus said to his disciples: 'You are the salt of the earth. But if salt becomes tasteless, what can make it salty again? It is good for nothing, and can only be thrown out to be trampled underfoot by men. 'You are the light of the world. A city built on a hill-top cannot be hidden. No one lights a lamp to put it under a tub: they put it on the lamp -stand where it shines for everyone in the house. In the same way your light must shine in the sight of men, so that, seeing your good works, they may give the praise to your Father in heaven.

The Gospel of the Lord. Praise to you Lord Jesus Christ.

COMMUNION ANTIPHON

Let them thank the Lord for his mercy, his wonders for the children of men, for he satisfies the thirsty soul, and the hungry he fills with good things.

MEDITATION:

the homeless poor, clothe the man you see to be naked and turn not Jesus used the image of salt to describe the transforming effect of from your own kin. Then will your light shine like the dawn and your God's work in our lives - and how the Holy Spirit wants to work wound be quickly healed over. Your integrity will go before you and through us to bring the power and blessing of God's kingdom to others. As salt purifies, preserves, and produces rich flavor for our daily and he will say, 'I am here.' If you do away with the yoke, the food, we, too, as disciples of Jesus, are "salt" for the world of human clenched fist, the wicked word, if you give your bread to the hungry, society. The Lord wants to work in and through us to purify, preserve, and relief to the oppressed, your light will rise in the darkness, and and spread the rich flavor of God's kingdom everywhere - his "kingdom of righteousness, peace, and joy in the Holy Spirit" (Romans 14:17). Jesus used the image of a lamp to describe how his disciples are to live in the light of his truth and love. Just as natural light illumines the darkness and enables one to see visually, so the light of Christ shines in the hearts of believers and enables us to see the heavenly reality of God's kingdom. Our mission is to be lightbearers of Jesus Christ so that others may see the truth of the gospel and be freed from the blindness of sin and deception. There is great freedom and joy for those who live in the light of God's truth and goodness. Do you know the joy and freedom of living in God's light?



Lord Jesus, you guide me by the light of your saving truth. Fill my heart and mind with your light and truth and free me from the blindness of sin and deception that I may see your ways clearly and understand your will for my life. May I radiate your light and truth to others in word and deed.


Seeking expressions of interest for a kids choir at 6:00pm Mass on the Fourth Sunday of each month.
