



GOSPEL ACCLAMATION

Alleluia, alleluia! Jesus Christ is the firstborn of the dead; glory and kingship be his for ever and ever. A reading from the holy Gospel according to Luke

Some Sadducees - those who say that there is no resurrection approached Jesus and they put this question to him, 'Master, we have it from Moses in writing, that if a man's married brother dies childless, the man must marry the widow to raise up children for his brother. Well, then, there were seven brothers. The first, having married a wife, died childless. The second and then the third married the widow. And the same with all seven, they died leaving no children. 2 Mc 7:1-2, 9-14 Finally the woman herself died. Now, at the resurrection, to which of them will she be wife since she had been married to all seven?' Jesus replied, 'The children of this world take wives and husbands, but There were seven brothers who were arrested with their mother. The those who are judged worthy of a place in the other world and in the king tried to force them to taste pig's flesh, which the Law forbids, by resurrection from the dead do not marry because they can no longer torturing them with whips and scourges. One of them, acting as die, for they are the same as the angels, and being children of the spokesman for the others, said, 'What are you trying to find out from resurrection they are sons of God. And Moses himself implies that us? We are prepared to die rather than break the Law of our ances- the dead rise again, in the passage about the bush where he calls tors.' With his last breath the second brother exclaimed, 'Inhuman the Lord the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac and the God of Jafiend, you may discharge us from this present life, but the King of the cob. Now he is God, not of the dead, but of the living; for to him all

The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want. Fresh and green are the pastures where he gives me repose, near restful waters he leads me.

MEDITATION:

Is your life earth-bound or heaven-bound? The Sadducees had one big problem - they could not conceive of heaven beyond what they could see with their naked eves! Aren't we often like them? We don't recognize spiritual realities because we try to make heaven into an earthly image. The Sadducees came to Jesus with a test question to make the resurrection look ridiculous. The Sadducees, unlike the (R.) Lord, when your glory appears, my joy will be Pharisees, did not believe in immortality, nor in angels or evil spirits. Their religion was literally grounded in an earthly image of heaven. May the Lord Jesus put his hands on our eyes also, for then we too shall begin to look not at what is seen but at what is not seen. May he open the eyes that are concerned not with the present but with what is yet to come, may he unseal the heart's vision, that we may gaze on God in the Spirit, through the same Lord, Jesus Christ, whose glory and power will endure throughout the unending succession of ages.
