and saw Abraham a long way off with Lazarus in his bosom. So he cried out, "Father Abraham, pity me and send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue, for I am in agony in these flames." Remember your word to your servant, O Lord, by which you have given me hope. This is my comfort when I am brought low.


MEDITATION:
