## 2:00pm PROCESSION OF DIVINE MERCY IMAGE

*(Note: The Procession Entourage will assemble at the foyer/back row of the church, x1 Acolyte, x1 Acolyte holding the Divine Mercy Image and the Priest or Priests and ending up at the main aisle before enthroning the image of the Divine Mercy at the Front of Church Main Altar. The Priest carries holy water and blesses people around the pews as the procession progress slowly towards the altar. A Hymn or two is sung during the procession.)*

### *Opening Prayer: Vida Aquam*

Celebrant: In the Name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen

All: I saw water flowing from the right side of the temple, alleluia; and all they to whom that water came were saved; and they shall say: alleluia, alleluia.

Celebrant. Praise the Lord, because He is good; because His mercy endureth forever. Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

All: As it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be world without end. Amen.

All: I saw water flowing from the right side of the temple, alleluia; and all they to whom that water came were saved; and they shall say: alleluia, alleluia.

Celebrant: Show us, O Lord, Thy mercy. Alleluia

All: And grant us Thy salvation. Alleluia.

Celebrant: O Lord, hear my prayer.

All: And let my cry come before Thee.

Celebrant: The Lord be with you.

All: And with thy spirit.

Celebrant: Let us pray. - Hear us, O Holy Lord, Almighty Father, everlasting God, and vouchsafe to send Thy holy Angel from heaven, to guard, cherish, protect, visit and defend all that are assembled in this place: through Christ our Lord. Amen.

*(Note: The Celebrant/Priest stands up and proceed to the Enthroned Divine Mercy Image and starts the prayer of the Solemn Blessing of the Divine Mercy Image.)*

## 2:10pm SOLEMN BLESSING OF DIVINE MERCY IMAGE

*(Note: All Kneel)*

### *Prayer for the Solemn Blessing of the Divine Mercy Image on Divine Mercy Sunday*

Celebrant: Almighty and Eternal Father, in Your goodness, bless and sanctify this Image of The Divine Mercy, Your dearly beloved Son, which has been fashioned to reveal to us, the great love of our Crucified and Risen Saviour, The Divine Mercy Personified.

Help us recall to our minds the streams of Blood and Water, that had gushed forth from His pierced Heart, to be for us a continuous fount of mercy. Grant to all who invoke Your Mercy with this Image before their eyes, the grace of true repentance, pardon and peace. Shield them from every danger to soul and body in this life.

Jesus, our loving Saviour, establish in this Image the Throne of Your Mercy. Pour out upon all of us, who approach it with faith and trust, the purifying, healing and sanctifying rays of grace ever emanating from it as a blazing star. Gaze upon us as You did from the Cross with Your great love and mercy so that we may be filled with Your grace.

Through this Image, may Your Divine Mercy triumph over all the powers of evil. May all who venerate this Image never perish. May it be their joy in life, their hope in death, and their glory in eternity forever and ever.

This we ask through Jesus Christ Our Lord. ALL: AMEN

- O Blessed Host, in whom is contained the infinite price of mercy which will compensate for all our debts, and especially those of poor sinners.
- O Blessed Host, in whom is contained the fountain of living water which springs from infinite mercy for us, and especially for poor sinners.
- O Blessed Host, in whom is contained the fire of purest love which blazes forth from the bosom of the Eternal Father, as from an abyss of infinite mercy for us, and especially for poor sinners.
- O Blessed Host, in whom is contained the medicine for all our infirmities, flowing from infinite mercy, as from a fount, for us and especially for poor sinners.
- O Blessed Host, in whom is contained the union between God and us through His infinite mercy for us, and especially for poor sinners.
- O Blessed Host, in whom are contained all the sentiments of the most sweet Heart of Jesus toward us, and especially poor sinners.
- O Blessed Host, our only hope in all the sufferings and adversities of life.
- O Blessed Host, our only hope in the midst of darkness and of storms within and without.

# THE DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET

## 1. Make the Sign of the Cross

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

## 2. Optional Opening Prayers

You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.

(Repeat three times)

O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You!

## 3. Our Father

Our Father, Who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil, Amen.

## 4. Hail Mary

Hail Mary, full of grace. The Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou amongst women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death, Amen.

## 5. The Apostle's Creed

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

## 6. The Eternal Father

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

## 7. On the Ten Small Beads of Each Decade

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

## 8. Repeat for the remaining decades

Saying the "Eternal Father" (6) on the "Our Father" bead and then 10 "For the sake of His sorrowful Passion" (7) on the following "Hail Mary" beads.

## 9. Conclude with Holy God (Repeat three times)

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

## 10. Optional Closing Prayer

Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion — inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.

## *Act of Consecration to Jesus the Divine Mercy*

*(Note: All Kneel Before the Blessed Sacrament)*

All: Most Merciful Lord, Jesus, Your goodness is endless, and the Treasury of Your graces is inexhaustible. I trust without limits in Your mercy, which is above all your works. I offer myself to You totally and without reservations, to strive towards Christian perfection and to live under the shelter of the rays which flowed from Your Divine Heart on the Cross. I desire to spread Your Mercy by performing deeds of mercy both for the soul as well as the body, especially by concern for the conversion of sinners, by bringing comfort to those in need of help, to the sick and the dejected, by praying for the dying and for the souls suffering in Purgatory. You, however, protect me as Your property and glory, for I am afraid of everything due to my weakness, but at the same time I expect everything from Your Mercy. Let all humankind come to know the immeasurable depth of Your Mercy, place its trust in It, and extol It for endless ages. AMEN

## 2:50pm **BENEDICTION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT**

### *Benediction: Tantum Ergo*
